



## One-Piece Oil Drain For Greddy TD06 Turbo Kit #

First let me thank you for purchasing this product! I hope that it lives up to your high expectations and helps to further your love of Toyota's. This oil drain is easy to install, and fits like a glove! The oil drain that Greddy provides is abysmal, and has contributed to a few engine fires and failures. The rubber hose they include is not rated for hot oil service, and promptly fails, causing loss of oil onto the hot exhaust. The Speed-Source replacement is formed from one piece of CNC bent tubing, and induction brazed to the flange. It is the proper size to match the stock rubber elbow off the oil pan, and has a formed hose retention bead.

Please allow the engine and turbo to cool before attempting installation. Remove the rubber hose and adaptor from the bottom of the turbo. Also remove the adaptor that fits into the stock rubber elbow at the pan. Now would be a great time to replace that elbow, Toyota part number is 15491-88380. Make sure the new one-piece oil drain tube is free from foreign material. (blow it out with air) You will need to clean the bottom of the turbo to make sure it is clean, with no gasket material left, and oil free. Wipe it with a cloth soaked in brake cleaner until it is no longer oily. This is very important to get the silicone to stick!

To install the new drain, slide the clamp down the rubber elbow out of the way, and insert the end of the new oil drain into the elbow. Apply a SMALL amount of automotive silicone sealer to both sides of the new gasket provided. Stick the gasket to the drain flange, and guide it into place under the turbo. Snug the bolts into the threaded holes, and check fit. Tighten the bolts, and adjust the rubber elbow on the drain, then slide the clamp onto the end of the rubber elbow. Now you are done! Wait for an hour or more until the sealer sets before you drive the car. CHECK FOR LEAKS! You should re-check the oil drain bolts in a few days.
